Information regarding final registration procedures is provided below. Applications of candidates who declare missing or incorrect documents/information during the application will not be accepted, and final registration procedures will not be performed. Candidates will be able to submit one application for each program type (at most one master's with thesis, one non-thesis Master's, and one doctoral program).

A) Application Requirements for the Master's Program with Thesis

- a) To hold an undergraduate degree.
- b) Verification of Turkish proficiency is not required for the application. Shortlisted candidates who possess a Turkish proficiency certificate will be eligible for final registration. Those without a Turkish proficiency certificate will be granted a preparatory period of up to two semesters. This preparatory period will not count towards the duration of the master's program. Students who fail to meet the language requirement by the end of this period will be dismissed from the University.

- c) Turkish language proficiency is not required for international student candidates who document that they have completed their undergraduate studies at a university where the medium of instruction is Turkish.
- d) To meet the requirements specified in the special conditions.

B) Application Requirements for the Doctoral Program

- a) To hold a Master's degree with thesis.
- b) For those applying to a doctoral program with an undergraduate degree, their undergraduate graduation grade point average must be at least 3.00 out of 4.00.
- c) Verification of Turkish proficiency is not required for the application. Shortlisted candidates who possess a Turkish proficiency certificate will be eligible for final registration. Those without a Turkish proficiency certificate will be granted a preparatory period of up to two semesters. This preparatory period will not count towards the duration of the master's program. Students who fail to meet the language requirement by the end of this period will be dismissed from the University.
- d) Turkish language proficiency is not required for international student candidates who document that they have completed their undergraduate or graduate studies at a university where the medium of instruction is Turkish.
- e) For admission to doctoral programs, to have a score of at least 55 obtained within the last 5 years from YDS, YÖKDİL, or international foreign language exams whose equivalence is accepted by YÖK, in a language other than their native language.
- f) To meet the requirements specified in the special conditions.

C) Application Requirements for the Non-Thesis Master's Program

- a) To hold an undergraduate degree.
- b) Verification of Turkish proficiency is not required for the application. Shortlisted candidates who possess a Turkish proficiency certificate will be eligible for final registration. Those without a Turkish proficiency certificate will be granted a preparatory period of up to two semesters. This preparatory period will not count towards the duration of the master's program. Students who fail to meet the language requirement by the end of this period will be dismissed from the University

- c) Turkish language proficiency is not required for international candidates who document that they have completed their undergraduate studies at a university where the medium of instruction is Turkish.
- d) To meet the requirements specified in the special conditions.

D) Online Application

- a) Online applications shall be made between the dates specified in the announcement through the **MENU, APPLICATION PROCEDURES, and INTERNATIONAL STUDENT INSTITUTE APPLICATION** tabs at the web address <http://ubys.bartın.edu.tr/>. Candidates may only apply to one program.
- b) Candidates are required to upload one passport-size photo, diploma (graduation certificate), graduation transcript of records (transcript), passport, and the notarized or Turkish Representation-approved Turkish translations of these documents. For PhD applications, candidates must also upload the foreign language exam result document.
- c) During the application process, candidates must upload/enter their documents/information accurately and completely. Applications of candidates who upload incomplete, incorrect, unapproved documents or documents without a verification code will not be accepted. In the event of a discrepancy between the uploaded document and the information entered into the system (whether in favor of or against the candidate), the candidate's application will be rejected.
- d) The approval and rejection status of applications can be checked from the application screen or via e-mail addresses. Candidates are required to check their approval status during the application period and update their application if there is an editable reason for rejection.

E) Evaluation and Student Admission

- a) **In Admission to Master's Programs with Thesis;** candidates are admitted to master's programs with thesis within the quota based on their undergraduate cumulative grade point average.
- b) **In Admission to Doctoral Studies;** candidates are admitted to doctoral programs within the quota by calculating 70% of the master's with thesis cumulative grade point average and 30% of the foreign language score from YDS, YÖKDİL, or an equivalent exam recognized by YÖK.
- c) **In Admission to Non-Thesis Master's Programs;** candidates are admitted to non-thesis master's programs within the quota based on their

undergraduate cumulative grade point average.

d) Student admission will be carried out after applications are evaluated according to the relevant provisions of the Bartın University Graduate Education and Training Regulation and the Bartın University Directive on Application, Admission, and Registration of International Student Candidates to Graduate Programs.

G) Documents Required for Final Registration

a) For applicants to Master's Programs, photocopies of the Bachelor's diploma; for applicants to Doctoral Programs, photocopies of the Bachelor's and Master's with Thesis diplomas (graduation certificate) are required, and the original documents are also necessary for the verification of the photocopies (an Apostille is required for those obtained abroad)

b) For applicants to Master's Programs, photocopies of the Bachelor's transcript; for applicants to Doctoral Programs, photocopies of the Bachelor's and Master's with Thesis transcripts (graduation transcript) are required, and the original documents are also necessary for the verification of the photocopies (an Apostille is required for those obtained abroad)

c) Turkish translations approved by a notary or a Turkish Representation of the Bachelor's diploma (graduation certificate) for Master's applicants; and of the Bachelor's and Master's with Thesis diplomas (graduation certificates), transcripts (graduation transcripts), and Passport for Doctoral applicants

d) Students who graduated from a university in Türkiye may submit printouts of their Graduation and Transcript documents obtained by downloading them from e-devlet.

- e) For doctoral programs, an international foreign language result document from YDS, YÖKDİL, or an equivalent recognized by YÖK, obtained within the last 5 years
- f) Passport document [the passport must contain a border gate entry stamp and a visa sticker (except for those within the scope of visa exemption).]
- g) A document showing legal stay status in Türkiye (one of the following: visa, residence permit, stateless person identity document, international protection identity document, temporary protection identity document, work permit, work permit exemption certificate, Blue Card, or Foreign Mission Personnel/Family Member Identity Card)
- h) 1 passport-sized photograph (taken within the last six months)
- i) Documents showing the payment of tuition and security deposit fees (receipt),
- j) For bachelor's and master's diplomas obtained from abroad, excluding health fields, a recognition certificate obtained from the Council of Higher Education regarding whether the institutions where they previously studied are recognized (except for refugees)
- k) For bachelor's and master's diplomas obtained abroad for health fields with clinical practice, a Diploma Equivalency Certificate
- l) Turkish Proficiency Certificate obtained from exams organized by institutions recognized by YÖK, if available
- m) Student residence permit to be obtained from the Directorate of Migration Management (to be submitted to the Graduate School within one month at the latest after registration.)

Note: Notary certification is not mandatory for the diploma (graduation certificate) for students who have a YÖK equivalence certificate or graduation recognition certificate.
