A) Requirements for the master's Program with Thesis

- a) To have a bachelor's degree,
- b) Verification of Turkish proficiency is not required for the application. Candidates who possess a Turkish proficiency certificate will be eligible for final registration. Those without a Turkish proficiency certificate will be granted a preparatory period of up to two semesters. This preparatory period will not count towards the duration of the master's program. Students who fail to meet the language requirement by the end of this period will be dismissed from the University,
- c) The Turkish language requirement is waived for international student candidates who can provide documentation confirming that they have completed their undergraduate studies at a university where the medium of instruction is Turkish,
- **d)** To fulfill the conditions specified in special conditions.

B) Requirements for the Doctoral (Ph.D.) Program

- a) To have a master's degree,
- b) Those who apply to the doctoral (Ph.D.) program with an undergraduate degree must have a minimum GPA (in bachelor's degree) of 3.00 out of 4.00,
- c) Verification of Turkish proficiency is not required for the application. Candidates who possess a Turkish proficiency certificate will be eligible for final registration. Those without a Turkish proficiency certificate will be granted a preparatory period of up to two semesters. This preparatory period will not

- count towards the duration of the doctoral (Ph.D.) program. Students who fail to meet the language requirement by the end of this period will be dismissed from the University,
- d) The Turkish language requirement is waived for international student candidates who can provide documentation confirming that they have completed their undergraduate studies at a university where the medium of instruction is Turkish,
- e) To be admitted to the doctoral program, candidates must have scored at least 55 points in the last 5 years on the YDS, YÖKDİL, or international foreign language exams recognized as equivalent by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK), other than their native language,
- f) To fulfill the conditions specified in special conditions.

C) Requirements for the Non-Thesis Master's Program

- a) To have a bachelor's degree,
- b) Verification of Turkish proficiency is not required for the application. Candidates who possess a Turkish proficiency certificate will be eligible for final registration. Those without a Turkish proficiency certificate will be granted a preparatory period of up to two semesters. This preparatory period will not count towards the duration of the master's program. Students who fail to meet the language requirement by the end of this period will be dismissed from the University,
- c) The Turkish language requirement is waived for international student candidates who can provide documentation confirming that they have completed their undergraduate studies at a university where the medium of instruction is Turkish,
- d) To fulfill the conditions specified in special conditions.

D) Application Requirements for Distance Education Non-Thesis Master's Program

- a) To have a bachelor's degree,
- b) Turkish language requirement is not required for the application. Those having a Turkish proficiency certificate among the candidates who are entitled to final registration are registered; Candidates without a Turkish proficiency certificate are given a preparation period of two semesters at most. This period is not counted for the education period of the master's program. At the end of this period, students who do not meet the language requirement are dismissed from the University,
- c) Turkish language requirement is not required for international student candidates who can submit a document that they have completed their undergraduate studies at a university, in which the teaching language is Turkish,

d) To fulfill the conditions specified in special conditions.

E) Online Application

- a) Online applications will be made through the MENU, APPLICATION PROCEDURES, and <u>INTERNATIONAL STUDENT GRADUATE SCHOOL</u>

 <u>APPLICATION</u> sections on the website http://ubys.bartin.edu.tr/ between the dates specified in the announcement.

 Candidates may apply to only one program,
- b) Candidates are required to upload one passport-size photo, diploma (graduation certificate), transcript, passport, and notarized or Turkish Consulate-approved Turkish translations of these documents. For PhD applications, candidates must also upload the foreign language exam result document,
- c) Candidates must provide accurate and complete information during their application. The declarations of the candidates will be considered as valid, and applications with incorrect or incomplete information will not be accepted,
- d) The approval or rejection status of applications can be checked on the application screen or via email. Candidates must monitor the status of their application during the application process and update their application if there is a correctable reason for rejection,
- e) It is essential to submit online applications in accordance with the relevant provisions of Bartin University's Graduate Education Regulations and the Directive for the Application, Admission, and Registration of International Student Candidates to Graduate Programs at Bartin University.

F) Evaluation and Student Admission

- a) In admission to master's Education with Thesis; Admission to master's programs with thesis is based on the undergraduate grade point average within the quota limits.
- b) In admission to Doctoral (Ph.D.) Education; Admission to doctoral programs is based on calculating 70% of the grade point average from the master's program with thesis and 30% of the foreign language score of YDS, YÖKDİL or other exams accepted by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) as equivalent, within the quota limits.
- c) In Admission to Non-Thesis Master's Education; Admission to non-thesis master's programs is based on the undergraduate grade point average within the quota limits.
- **d)** Admission to Distance Education Non-Thesis Master's Education; Admission to distance education non-thesis master's programs is based on the lisans undergraduate grade point average within the quota limits.

e) After the applications are evaluated in accordance with the Bartın University Graduate Education and Training Regulations and the Bartın University Regulations on Application, Acceptance, and Registration of International Student Candidates to Graduate Programs, student admissions will be conducted.

H- Required Documents for Final Registration

- a) For applicants to the Master's Program: the original and copies of the Bachelor's degree diploma-graduation certificate; for applicants to the PhD Program: the original and copies of the Bachelor's and Thesis Master's degrees diplomas-graduation certificates,
- b) For applicants to the Master's Program: the original and copies of the Bachelor's transcript (graduation transcript); for applicants to the PhD Program: the original and copies of the Bachelor's and Thesis Master's transcripts,
- c) Passport document [the passport must include an entry stamp from the border crossing and a visa sticker (except for those exempt from a visa)],

- d) A document showing legal residency status in Türkiye (one of the following: visa, residence permit, stateless person identity card, international protection identity card, temporary protection identity card, work permit, work permit exemption certificate, blue card, or foreign mission staff/family member identity card),
- e) For applicants to the Master's Program: notarized or Turkish Consulate-approved Turkish translations of the Bachelor's degree diploma-graduation certificate and transcript (graduation transcript), and passport; for applicants to the PhD Program: notarized or Turkish Consulate-approved Turkish translations of the Bachelor's and Thesis Master's degrees diplomas-graduation certificates and transcripts, and passport,
- f) For undergraduate and graduate diplomas obtained abroad (except for health fields): a recognition certificate from the Council of Higher Education in Türkiye (YÖK) regarding whether the institution where the applicant studied is recognized (except for refugees),
- g) For health fields with clinical practice: a Diploma Equivalency Certificate for undergraduate and graduate diplomas obtained abroad,
- h) For PhD programs: a foreign language exam result document (YDS, YÖKDİL, or an international exam recognized as equivalent by YÖK) obtained within the last 5 years.
- i) One passport-size photo (taken within the last six months),
- j) Documents showing the payment of tuition and security deposit fees (receipt),
- k) If available, a Turkish Proficiency Certificate from an exam conducted by an institution recognized by YÖK,
- 1) Students who graduated from a university in Türkiye can submit printed copies of their Graduation and Transcript documents downloaded from the e-Government portal,
- m) A study residence permit document to be obtained from the Directorate of Migration Management (must be submitted to the Graduate School within one month after registration),

Note: For students who have a YÖK equivalency certificate or a graduation recognition certificate, a notarized copy of the diploma (graduation certificate) is not required.
